Who chooses the winners?

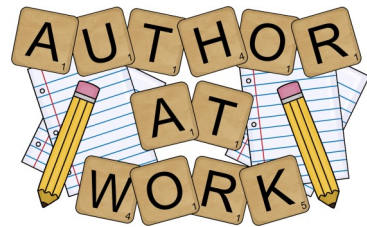
Books will be assessed by a group of teachers based on writing traits and creativity.

Guidelines

ENTRY GUIDELINES:

- *Stories must be original student work
- *Acceptable entries may include these basic types of literature: -Imaginative stories (animal stories, fairy tales, legends, myths) -Non-fiction: biographies and personal narratives - Poetry Collection -Drama: plays

*Illustrations must be original and drawn by hand not traced

*Stories must be neatly written, typed or computer printed. **Books should include a dedication page.**

*Your story will be graded on a four point scale (not evident, poor, good, strong) in the following: Title, Beginning, Middle, End, Plot, Details, Originality, Fluency, Presentation, Overall Rating
